TRAVEL AND TOURISM EVENING COURSE

Successful completion of the Travel and Tourism Evening Course (secondary school course) leads to the attainment of a nationally recognised **high school diploma in tourism** (perito turistico).

The Course is a part of the Italian national education system but it has been designed to allow for more **flexibility and decentralization** in order to meet the needs of those wishing to re-enter the education system.

The tourism sector involves an ever-growing number of people, both service providers and consumers, and it is a very prominent economic and cultural activity which requires trained personnel not only at staff level, but also in charge of management functions and intermediary promotion.

The Evening Course is designed to provide the "tourism knowledge" and "executive skills" by providing general cultural instruction aimed at:

- qualifying young people and adults who need to update their professional competences;
- retraining those who are already inserted in the working environment and wish to transform their professional identity.

The Course design has proved to be a valid "alternative" educational opportunity and differs from the traditional standard curriculum in the following aspects:

- reduced weekly schedule;
- credits recognition (work experience and skills not necessarily officially certified qualifications);
- **tutoring and teaching methods** aimed to enhance the cultural and professional experiences of the students and develop:
 - o language and communication skills as a practical international communication tool, but also as means to understand the "culture" of foreign travellers, their expectations, needs, etc.
 - o **professional skills** understood as the ability to perform, in a modern and effective way, entrepreneurial and management functions in small and medium-sized enterprises in tourism industry.
